Jean-Marie Chevalier is currently Professor of Economics at the University of Paris-Dauphine, Director of the Centre de Géopolitique de l'Energie et des Matières Premières (CGEMP). He is also a Senior Associate at Cambridge Energy Research Associates (IHS/CERA, Paris office), member of the Conseil d'Analyse Economique (CAE) of the French Prime Minister, member of the Cercle des Economistes. He has published numerous books and articles on energy economics and industrial organization. The most recent are : *Les grandes batailles de l'énergie* (2005), *Les marchés européens du gaz et de l'électricité : un défi pour l'Europe et pour la France* (2008), *Les 100 mots de l'énergie* (2008), *The New Energy Crisis: Climate, Economics and Geopolitics* (2009), *Report on Oil Price Volatility* (Report for Mrs Christine Lagarde, French Minister of Economy, Industry and Employment 2010). Jean-Marie Chevalier graduated from the Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris and holds a PhD in economics from the University Pantheon-Sorbonne. He is professeur agrégé des Facultés de Sciences Economiques.
